- Nearly 60% of our participants move on to more permanent forms of housing!
- Most get jobs while they are with us.
- The average stay is 4.5 months.

Our 5-Level Case Management system seems to be the “secret sauce” of operating a successful tiny house village for the homeless. Our Police Chief and City Manager love the village and actually encouraged us to expand last year from 14 to 30 tiny houses.
